COLLECTION SERVICE

Rates are based on the size and frequency of service. Trash collection is available in a variety of size containers — including carts (35, 65, or 95 gallon), bins (1.5 to 6 yards), roll-off boxes (10 to 30

yards), and compactors. Please call for more information.

NRWS/NCRWS provides recycling and yard trimmings compost collection at no extra charge to all its business customers. Service is available in carts or bins. For large generators, roll-off service is available for recycling (free) and yard trimmings (at a discounted rate). NRWS/NCRWS also collects bulky items and large amounts of special recyclable materials, such as e-waste and pallets. In addition, we accept clean shrink wrap consolidated in clear bags for recycling. 

PREVENT RECYCLING THEFT

Recyclable materials belong **to you**. You may choose to take your cans and bottles to a buyback center and be paid their California Redemption Value (CRV) or you may choose to put your recyclables in the NRWS carts or bins. Once those materials are in the recycling cart or bin, only you or NRWS has the right to remove them. The recyclables have value, and the revenue NRWS receives from processing recyclables is taken into consideration when solid waste rates are set.
