COMING LATE 2023

- Development: Rehabilitation of the vacant Sunrise assisted living facility into 66 apartments consisting of studio and onebedroom units.
- Amenities: Community room with kitchen, laundry facilities, bicycle parking, outdoor courtyard, and administrative offices.



COMING EARLY 2024

- Development: New construction of 24 multi-family apartments consisting of 1 BR, 2 BR, and 3BR units
- Amenities: Community room, laundry facilities, bicycle parking, playground, outdoor recreation space for families to gather and play



Valle Verde Affordable Family & Farmworker Housing



Joe Serna, Jr. Farmworker Housing Grant Program (FWHG)



 Helps fund new construction, rehabilitation, and acquisition for agricultural workers, with a priority for lower income households. Financing Farmworker Housing



For Serna funding, the worker must meet the eligibility program requirements (Immigration Status **not** considered):

- Household is an "Agricultural Employee" as defined by the Serna Farmworker Program statue and regulations
- Meets the income guidelines
- Meets the occupancy guidelines

*Definition for Agricultural Employment: ·Cultivation and tillage of the soil ·Production, cultivation, growing and harvesting of any agricultural or horticultural commodities ·Raising of livestock, bees, fur-bearing animals, or poultry Dairying Forestry Lumbering operations

Income Limits Don't Match Reality

2022 Napa County 30% Area Median Income (AMI) for a single household = \$26,490

30% AMI is a difficult needle to thread, preventing many from accessing affordable housing.
